 3. **Paragraph 3**-Summarize another habit from the book that made an impact on you as you read. Discuss any habits that you already practice in your everyday life.
 4. **Paragraph 4**-Summarize yet another habit from the book that made an impact on you as you read. Discuss any habits that you already practice in your everyday life.
 5. **Paragraph 5**-Write about how you plan to incorporate these habits into your life to become a more effective teen.
 6. **Paragraph 6**-Discuss how you will use the information you learned from this book to encourage others to be effective teens. Be specific.
 7. **Paragraph 7**-Conclusion
